TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS

ROADS ACT 1993 – SECTION 75

ROADS REGULATIONS 1994 – ARTICLE 12

NOTICE OF INTENTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council proposes to make an order closing the following sections of road for the periods stated hereunder to facilitate the installation of services for the Tuam Town Water Distribution and Main Drainage Scheme Phase 2:

Bishop Street, between the Bishop Street/Curragh Park Junction and the Bishop Street/Dunmore Road junction from 8.00a.m. on Monday 5th September 2011 to 6.00p.m. on Friday 25th November 2011.

Alternative Routes:

Dunmore Road, Bobby Burke Road, N17 (Galway - Tuam) Full detour details are available from the Roads & Transportation Unit, Galway County Council, Áras an Chontae, Prospect Hill, Galway.

Documents can be inspected at the Roads & Transportation Unit, Áras an Chontae, Prospect Hill, Galway, during normal office hours. Objections to the proposed temporary closure may be submitted in writing to the **Director of Services, Roads, Transportation, Marine & General Services, Galway County Council, Áras an Chontae, Prospect Hill, Galway** not later than **12.00 p.m. on Friday 29th July 2011.**

NOTICES OF DECISION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council has made an order closing subject to conditions the L85703 Market Square, Kinvara to public traffic from 7.00a.m. to 3.30p.m. on Friday 12th August 2011 to facilitate the Kinvara Farmers Market.

Alternative Route:

Adjacent supermarket access road.

Access to properties affected by this closure will be maintained via the adjacent supermarket access road and carpark.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council has made an order closing subject to conditions the LS-7113 in the townland of Crusheeny to public traffic from Monday 22nd August 2011 to Friday 24th February 2012 to facilitate the replacement of Crusheeny Bridge.

Local access will be maintained up to 100m on either side of the bridge.

Alternative Route:

Traffic travelling from the northern side (N17) will be diverted at the junction with local road LS-7114 in the townland of Kiniska onto the Cregmore Road and take a right turn at Cregmore Cross-Roads onto the N18.

Traffic travelling from the southern side (N18) will be diverted at the junction with local road LS-7110 in the townland of Gortatleava onto the Lydacan Road and take a left turn at Cregmore Cross-Roads onto the N17.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council has made an order closing subject to conditions a section of the R351 Woodford Road from its junction with Cross Street/Moore Street in the town of Loughrea for a distance of 120 meters in a southerly direction from 8.00a.m. on Monday 15th August 2011 to 8.00a.m. on Monday 22nd August 2011 to facilitate the replacement of a storm water culvert on the R351 as part of OPW Non-Coastal Minor Works and Studies Scheme.

Alternative Route:

Traffic travelling from Kylebrack/Woodford to Loughrea will turn left at the junction of the L4215 with the R351 in the townland of Aille and shall continue on the L4215 to Killeenadeema Village and the L4216 to its junction with the N66 in the townland of Cuscarrick. Traffic will turn right at this junction and continue along the N66 to Loughrea town.

Traffic travelling from Loughrea town to Kylebrack/Woodford will travel along the N66 to the junction of the L4216 with the N66 in the townland of Cuscarrick. Traffic will turn left at this junction and continue along the L4216 to Killeenadeema village and the L4215 to its junction with the R351 in the townland of Aille. Traffic will turn right at this junction and continue on the R351 to Kylebrack.

ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway County Council in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 and in the interests of road safety, has made orders to apply a Road Works Speed Limit of 50km/hr. at the following locations:
