Galway County Council commits to achieving a:

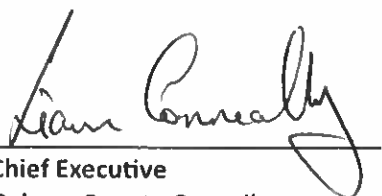
- 51% reduction in Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions *(Baselines: average 2016-2018 levels)*
- 51% reduction in Thermal and Transport (non-electric) GHG emissions, and
- 50% improvement in energy efficiency *(Baseline: 2009 level)*

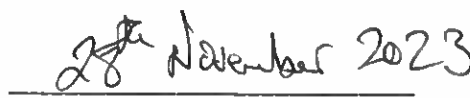
The Senior Management Team will ensure this policy is appropriate to the nature and scale of the organisation's energy use and consumption and, will lead the programmes to deliver these reductions and improvements by 2030.

Galway County Council will:

- Provide a framework for setting and reviewing appropriate objectives and energy targets
- Commit to ensuring the Organisation remains compliant with all applicable legal and other requirements
- Commit to continuously improving the Organisation's energy performance and Energy Management System
- Support the procurement of energy-efficient products and services that impact energy performance
- Support design activities that consider energy performance improvement
