13. Cllr. Shelly Herterich Quinn

I will propose:

“that Galway County Council writes to our colleagues in all other Local Authorities and informs them of the recent decision by Galway City and County Councils to support and endorse the rollout of the Public Recognition Marker (PRM) for the LGBTQI+ Community.

In doing so, I call upon all local authorities to work with their respective LGBTQI+ Community Leaders in advocating for the same.”

14. Cllr. Gabe Cronnelly

I will propose:

“that Galway County Council calls on the Minister of Social Protection, Heather Humphreys TD and the Minister for Arts, Culture and Heritage, Catherine Martin TD, to find a solution which would allow artists with disabilities to be in receipt of the Basic Income for Artists payment without it affecting their disability supports and requests the introduction of a pilot scheme for artists with disabilities, to co-exist for the duration of the Basic Income for Artists pilot scheme, which would remove the weekly earnings limit & means test from those in receipt of disability supports.”

15. Cllr. Martina Kinane

I will propose:

“that in the absence of any recreational amenities in Oranhill Estate, Galway County Council allocate funding sourced from the County Council Development Contribution Scheme to the Oranhill Property Management Company to cover the costs of undertaking the necessary remedial works required, to provide an adequate playing space for the children to use in Oranhill.”

I believe this is the minimum first step required in addressing the non-existence of recreational space and amenities in the Oranhill Estate.
