The Cathaoirleach welcomed everyone to the Athenry Oranmore MD AGM and he thanked the staff for all their assistance while he was Cathaoirleach.

In his outgoing address, Cllr. Carroll said he had several highlights while in office which included the recent announcement by Dexcom to set up their European Headquarters in Athenry. This will be a gamechanger for Athenry town and its hinterland. The presentation by Iarnrod Eireann which highlighted the provision of a second platform in Oranmore and he said that it is anticipated that a planning application for this will be lodged in the coming months. By 2025 it is hoped that a new bus connect plan will provide a bus service from the city through the coast road and on to Oranhill. He said however, it was remiss not to have included Claregalway in this plan.

He also said that the upcoming planned traffic calming works at Claregalway is very welcome and Cllr's Cuddy, Charity and Collins worked hard on this project.

The village of Oranmore received investment allowing footpath works to be carried out around the village in areas such as the Station Road and the Old Dublin Road. He also welcomed the road restoration and flood works on the Coast Road and the new pedestrian crossing on the N67.

Cllr. Carroll also thanked the Tidy Towns committee and the CE scheme in Oranmore for all their hard work.

He said that the funding for the outdoor infrastructure in Oranmore village was also very welcome. The Department of Education have recently purchased a 15 acre site at Gurrane for the construction of 1,000 pupil secondary school for Educate Together to meet with the large growth in population in the Oranmore area.

Cllr. Carroll thanked the press for their diligent covering of the MD meetings.

The Members complimented Cllr. Carroll for overseeing the MD meetings in the past year and thanked him for all the progress made in the Municipal District Area.
