Former Cathaoirleach, Frank Kearney, welcomed all present to the first meeting of the new Athenry Municipal District following the Local Elections and congratulated Cllrs. Cuddy, Charity and Cronnelly on re-election and Cllrs. Carroll, Collins, Dolan and Herterich Quinn on their election.

He acknowledged the presence in the Council Chamber of Mr. Peter Feeney, former County Councillor and first Cathaoirleach of the Athenry-Oranmore Municipal District Council.

He said that, in accordance with the Standing Orders of the Municipal District Council, the Members were required to nominate a person to take the Chair pending the election of a new Cathaoirleach.

On the **PROPOSAL** of Cllr. Carroll, **SECONDED** by Cllr. Cuddy, the Members **AGREED** that the Meetings Administrator, Ms. Healy, take the Chair pending the election of a Cathaoirleach.

Ms. Healy thanked Mr. Kearney for attending the Meeting and wished him well in the future.

**Item No. 1: Election of Cathaoirleach of Athenry Municipal District Council for 2019-2020**

Cllr. Carroll **PROPOSED** that Cllr. Cuddy be elected as Cathaoirleach and this proposal was **SECONDED** by Cllr. Cronnelly and **AGREED**.

Cllr. Cuddy **ACCEPTED** the nomination.

As there was no other nomination, the Cathaoirleach **DECLARED** Cllr. Jim Cuddy **ELECTED** as Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District Council of Athenry for the year 2019/2020.

Cathaoirleach Cuddy then assumed the Chair.

The newly elected Cathaoirleach thanked his proposer and seconder and said he was delighted to have been elected without opposition and he thanked all of the Members for their support. He paid tribute to the previous Cathaoirleach, Frank Kearney, stating that he had been an outstanding Cathaoirleach for the past year, meeting challenges and carrying out his duties in a very professional and efficient manner.

Cathaoirleach Cuddy also acknowledged the contribution over the past five years of Cllrs. Noone, and Feeney who did not run for re-election in the Local Elections 2019. He also wished to acknowledge the work of Cllr. Kinane who, due to the boundary changes implemented in 2019, is now a Member of the Loughrea Municipal District and wished to extend his congratulations to her.

The newly elected Cathaoirleach said his priorities during his term would be to continue to lobby for adequate funding for the Municipal District for road works, focus on planning issues, playing areas and green spaces, the issue of transport, global warming issues and staffing of the Local Authority. He also said that funding for burial grounds is a priority and also bottle banks. He said that his focus would be to progress these key priority areas.

All of the Members congratulated Cllr. Cuddy on his election as Cathaoirleach and they wished Frank Kearney and Peter Feeney well in their future.

Cllr. D. Collins thanked Mr. Kearney for his work for the Municipal District over the previous five years and he said that the people of Lackagh and Turloughmore appreciate his work and wish him health into the future.

Mr. Owens acknowledged the work of the previous Cathaoirleach, Frank Kearney, on his own behalf and on behalf of the Staff of Corporate Services, the Roads Section and the Staff across the whole of the Council. He acknowledged his support and assistance during his term of office and the manner in which he Chaired the Meetings, facilitated the engagement between Members and Officials and ensured that the Meetings took place in an efficient manner.

Mr. Owens welcomed the newly elected Cathaoirleach, Cllr. Cuddy, stating that his experience and knowledge would ensure that he carries out his duties in a very efficient manner. He assured the Cathaoirleach that the staff across the Municipal District would assist him during the coming year.

He extended his congratulations to the Municipal District Members who had been re-elected in the Local Elections, Cllr. Charity, Cllr. Cronnelly and Cllr. Cuddy. He also wished to extend congratulations to Cllr. Martina Kinane on her re-election to the Council although he said she is now a Member of the Loughrea Municipal District Council as a result of the boundary commission changes which came into effect following the Local Elections.

Dolan, stating that he and the staff of the Municipal District were available to assist and support them and he wished them well in their work on the Council.


